ALLFIE is a Disabled people's Organisation (DPO) that fights for **inclusion and equality in education.**



We believe all Disabled people **deserve to learn alongside** non-Disabled people in mainstream setting.



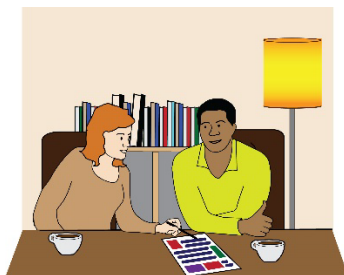
We do this because **we know inclusion works.**



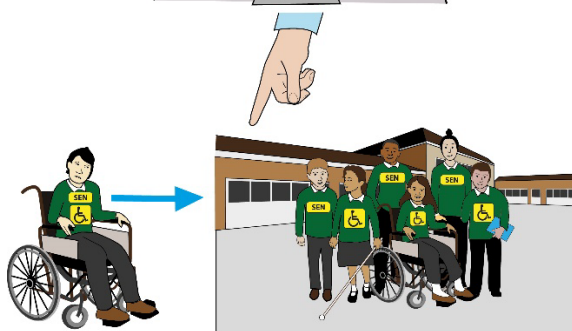
But we also know that Disabled people are **being failed** in lots of ways by the current education system.



Our manifesto promotes equality and the **right to inclusive education** for ALL Disabled people.



We want to see more support for disabled pupils or students in mainstream settings.



Our manifesto sets out six demands for creating an inclusive education system:

1. **Inclusive Education Law:**

A law that guarantees Disabled people's right to inclusive education with the necessary support.

2. **End Segregated Education:**

Closing special schools and units, **prioritising inclusive learning** for all.

3. **Funding for Mainstream Services:**

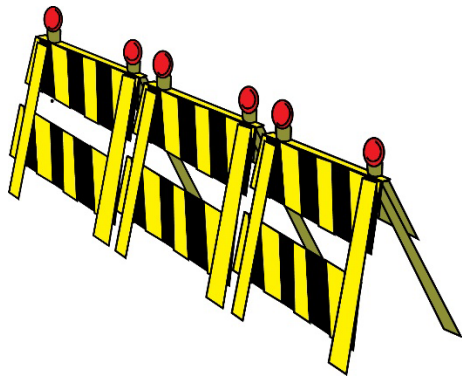
Direct resources to improve mainstream schools to support Disabled students.



4. **Fair Curriculum and Assessment:** Change the system to ensure fair learning and testing for everyone.



5. **Inclusive Education Training:** Train all teachers and supporters on inclusive practice.



6. **Combat Social Injustice:** Address all forms of discrimination in education, including those based on race, gender, and socioeconomic background.



We believe that an inclusive education system that meets the needs of all Disabled people from childhood, and supports life-long learning, **is the foundation to an inclusive society.**
